



# How to get there

## BY RAIL AND BUS

If you are travelling to Leeds by public coach or rail, you may wish to use a local bus service. Please ask your family group representative for a copy of the newly published bus timetable. Buses 2, 3, 3A and 25 go to the stadium. Board them at stops K1 and K2 on New Market Street – which is just outside the Corn Exchange in Leeds city centre.

To get to these bus stops from the railway station: turn right on exiting the station, walk along Boar Lane and then Duncan Street for about 300 yards.

At the end of Duncan Street you will see the Corn Exchange (a large round building) straight ahead.

The bus stops are in a line to the left on the opposite side of the road.

Buses take you through the city centre and onto the Dewsbury Road. South Leeds Stadium is a couple of miles up Dewsbury Road. There is

a bus stop just after the junction for the SLS. At this junction (traffic light controlled) there is a Kwik Fit on the left.

## BY TAXI

There is a taxi rank at the train station – or use a local firm, some of whom are listed here:

## BY ROAD

See map. Note that there will be roadworks on the M621 at Junction 5 so you may wish to use the M62 and leave at Junction 28 – or leave the M621 at Junction 1. South Leeds Stadium is signposted on both routes.
